Survey assessment:

The survey was addressed to the students of Partner countries. It concerned Citizens' Social Competences on Climate Protection, Prevention and effects of Climate Change. 29 students took part in the survey (05/2020)

1. To the question: What is your main source of information on global warming?

82,8% of respondents chose: Internet

58,6% - Television 44,8 % - School

2. To the question: <u>Do the ecological organizations operating in your country influence your knowledge about global warming and climate change?</u>

89,7% of respondents answered: yes

10.3%: no

3. To the question: <u>Do you talk to your friends about global warming on Earth and climate</u> change

86,2% of respondents answered: yes

13,8%: no

4. To the question: <u>Do you think global warming and climate change can be a threat to your life?</u>

93,1% of respondents answered: yes

6,9%: no

5. To the question: Who can do more something to prevent global warming?

86,2% of respondents chose: Everyone

55,2% - International organizations

51,7 % - National governments

37,9% - Companies, large corporations

0% - Nobody

6. To the question: Do you think you have an impact on climate change?

58, 6% - Yes

34,5% - Rather yes

6,9% - No, rather not, I don't know

7. To the question: Would you be willing to personally engage in tackling global warming?

44,8% - Yes

44.8% - Rather yes

10,3% - I don't know

8. To the question: Have you heard about international climate initiatives?

44,8% of respondents answered: yes

55,2%: no

9. To the question: <u>How do you assess the actions of your country's authorities in the context of counteracting climate change?</u>

3,5% -Very good

31% - Good

20,7% - Enough

44,8% - Not enough

10. To the question: Which of the issues listed below are the most and the least interesting for you?

The most interesting for the respondents are (very interesting -over 50%):

a/ What natural disasters will occur: floods, hurricanes, droughts and in which regions of the world? (51,7%)

b/ How will the climate change in Europe? (51,7%)

c/ What problems will people face if the climate on Earth changes? (69%)

d/ How climate change and the coronavirus are linked? (55,2%)

Conclusions:

Most of the respondents are interested in the issue of climate protection and want to join preventive measures:

86,2% of respondents talk to their friends about global warming on Earth and climate change

93,1% think that the global warming and climate change can be a threat to their life

86,2% think that everyone can do more something to prevent global warming but

international organizations (55,2%) and national governments (51,7%) should play a key role.

93,1% of respondents think that they have an impact on climate change

89,6% are ready to engage in tackling global warming

44.8% of respondents think that their governments are not doing enough to protect the climate They get the most information on climate protection and climate change from the Internet (82,8%).

They are most interested in issues:

What natural disasters will occur: floods, hurricanes, droughts and in which regions of the world? (51,7%)

How will the climate change in Europe? (51,7%)

What problems will people face if the climate on Earth changes? (69%)

How climate change and the coronavirus are linked? (55,2%)


Recommendations:

Generally, students are aware of the occurring climate change and express their will to join actions for climate protection. They really want to act!


As many activities as possible under the project should be undertaken: meetings (including online), discussions, conferences, workshops, information campaigns in local communities.




2. Would you like to have a friend with other skin colour than yours? 43 odpowiedzi




3. Would you like to have a friend from other country? 43 odpowiedzi




4. Do you accept existence of religions other than yours? 43 odpowiedzi




5. Do you like your country becoming multicultural? 43 odpowiedzi
