The survey was addressed to the students of Partner countries. It concerned social attitudes towards other opportunities, cultures and languages. 43 students took part in the survey.

1. To the question: Are you open to other cultures?

**82,9%** of respondents answered – yes

**4,9%** - no

**12,2 %** - not to every culture

2. To the question: Would you like to have a friend with other skin colour than yours?

**93%** of respondents answered - yes

**7%** - no

3. To the question: Would you like to have a friend from other country?

**88,4%** of respondents answered - yes

**11,6%** - no

4. To the question: Do you accept existence of religions other than yours?

**74,4%** of respondents answered - yes

**7%** - no

**18,6%** - not every religion

5. To the question: Do you like your country becoming multicultural?

**69,8%** of respondents answered - yes

**11,6%** - no

**18,6%** - I have no opinion

6. To the question: Are you open to accepting immigrants into your country?

**58,1%** of respondents answered - yes

**11,6%** - no

**30,2%** - not every immigrant

7. To the question: How many languages would you like to learn at a communicative level?

**55,8%** - as many as possible

**30,2%** - 1 - 5

**7%** - 6 - 10

**7%** - None

8. To the question: Would you like other cultures becoming part of yours?

**53,5%** of respondents answered - yes

**23,3,3 %** - no

**23,3%** - I have no opinion

**Conclusions:**

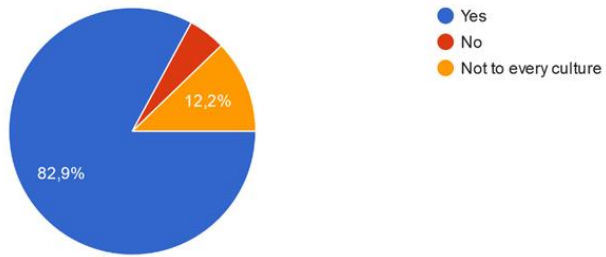
- Most respondents declare themselves open to another culture. They accept friends from a different country (88,4%), culture and skin colour (93%).
- 74.4% accept existence of religions other than their religion
- 58.1% are open to accepting immigrants into their country, but 30.2% - not every immigrant.
- The respondents have a great attachment to their culture. Only 53.5% like other cultures becoming part of their. 23.3% are definitely against, and 23.3% have no opinion on this subject

- Organize workshops: Cultural and linguistic diversity in the modern world

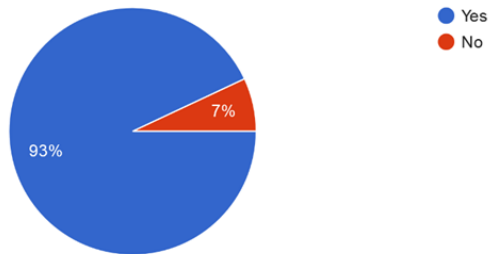

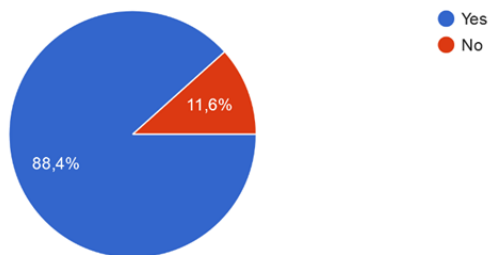
2. Would you like to have a friend with other skin colour than yours?

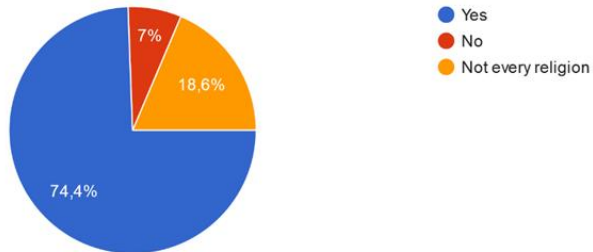
3. Would you like to have a friend from other country ?

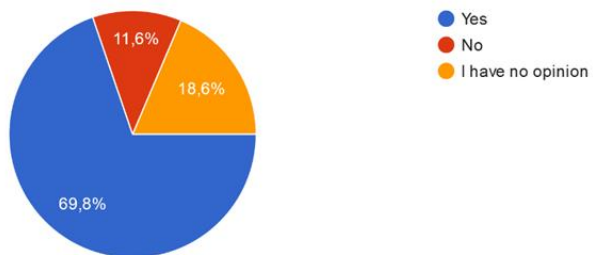
4. Do you accept existence of religions other than yours?

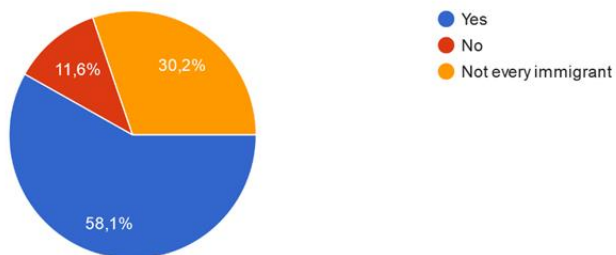
5. Do you like your country becoming multicultural?

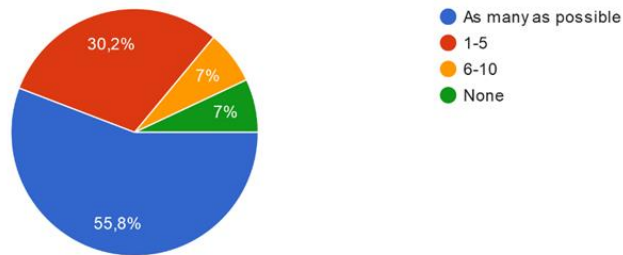
6. Are you open to accepting immigrants into your country?
